

SHOEBOXES FOR MEXICO

STEP ONE

Get a standard shoebox-sized **plastic container** (no cardboard containers, please). Please **do not wrap** your shoebox. Boxes often need to be opened and checked when crossing customs.

STEP TWO

Decide whether your Christmas gift will be for a boy(niño), or a girl(niña), and choose between teen- or child-age. Cut out the appropriate gift label to the right. Mark the correct age category on the label, and tape the label to the top of the box.

STEP THREE

Fill the box with a variety of gifts that will bring joy to a child. Place a rubber band around the shoe box and lid, and drop off by **December 7th** at Heights Kids at either our Prescott or Prescott Valley Location.

GIFT IDEAS

TOYS

Small cards, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoo's, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small Etch A Sketch, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries), Slinky, etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Pens, pencils and sharpener, crayons or markers, stamps and ink pad sets, writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

HYGIENE ITEMS

Toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, etc.

OTHER

Hard candy and lollipops (please double bag all candy), mints, gum, t-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries)

A PERSONAL NOTE

In a separate envelope, you may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. (if you include your name and address, the child can write back).

DO NOT INCLUDE

Breakable/choking hazards (porcelain and glass items, beads, aerosol cans, etc), Used or damaged items, food, chocolate, vitamins, medications, or war-related items (e.g. toy guns, knives, military figurines).
