Everyday Worship

Worshiping God as a family sounds like a great idea—but how? Here are simple, age-appropriate ideas:

- Ask, "What can we thank God for that is red?" After each family member tells, pray briefly and mention every idea. Ask a different question each day. Thanking God together IS family worship!
- Read a short Bible story at bedtime.
- Sing a praise song your children understand and love while you ride in the car or walk to the park.
   (This can quickly become a family tradition!)

Begin each meal with a thank-You-God prayer—even at the drive-thru.




People praised Jesus because they loved Him. We love Jesus. We can praise Him, too!

### Bible Story

Matthew 21:1-11,15-16; Luke 19:28-38

Walk your fingers whenever you say the word **walk**. Cup your hands around your mouth whenever you say the word **shout**. Invite your child to copy your motions. **For older children:** How many branches can you find in this picture?

Jesus told His friends, "Walk to the place I tell you to go to. You will find a donkey there. Untie it and bring it to Me."

Jesus' friends walked. They found the donkey. They brought the donkey back to Jesus. Jesus' friends spread their coats on the donkey's back. Jesus sat on the donkey. The donkey began to walk down the road to Jerusalem. Jesus' friends came, too.


Many other people **walked** on the road. They began to **shout**, "Look! Jesus is coming!"



People wanted Jesus to know they were glad to see Him! They **shouted** praises to Jesus. Some people laid branches on the road. Some people laid their coats on the road. The road looked like a

### Family Talk

- When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey, what did people do with leaves and branches?

### Prayer Time

## Things to talk about:

- What Bible verse do you know about praising Jesus? [Repeat today's Bible verse with your child.]
- What are some words we could say to praise Jesus? To tell Him we love Him?

### Words to pray together:

Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us. We [repeat words your child said]. We are glad to praise You because we love You!
