WHAT + WHEN


The Welcome Project will:

Q: Have we begun the design of the expanded Welcome Center. Lobby and Patio?

A: CamCC engaged a team of volunteers to dream up what the future on our campus could look like. We then had artistic renderingss made of the proposed improvements. The architectural blueprints will be completed after the fundraising is completed.

Q: Will we be required to incur additional debt?

A: CamCC will not incur debt beyond what is pledged. However, we will secure a short-term loan equal to the pledge amount so that we can begin construction in 2023. With the ever-increasing cost of construction, it would be less expensive to borrow the money and start construction now while costs are lower.

Q: Why are we expanding our facilities rather than planting more churches?

A: We love missions and church planting here at CamCC. In fact, 10% of our budget goes outside our walls for these very purposes. At the same time, we have a mission here in Camarillo that we take very seriously. The plan to invest in our facility is directly linked to our mission of reaching this city with the Gospel and to do our part in fulfilling the great commission.

Q. What are you asking our family to do during Commitment Weeks?

A: At the end of each service during the Commitment Weeks, the people of Camarillo Community Church will be given an opportunity to make a one-time gift and turn in a three-year pledge reflecting their commitment to The Welcome Project. Also, there are other ways that you can give in addition to checks, cash, and online donations on that day. Our church will also be prepared to receive gifts of real property, including stocks, jewelry, vehicles, and land. People who desire to give may consider these items much more practical to donate. Also, there may be significant tax advantages to donating items that have appreciated in value since their purchase. Q. When do we hope to begin the expansions?

A: Once we have the opportunity to collect all of the gifts and pledges, we will announce the total on Victory Day, which will be December 4th. Once we determine what the Lord has provided, we will move forward immediately to put the funds to work and bring the vision of The Welcome Project to life. We anticipate about a year between the start of our project and its completion. That means we need to get ready for an exciting 2024!
