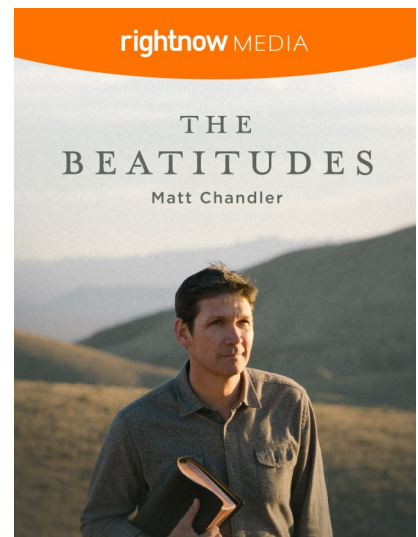

Habitat for Humanity is one of Kingston Presbyterian Church’s missions that we support. KPC was the first church in Conway to step forward to assist Habitat with a “Faith Build.” I compare the people from our church to that “Rock” that Matthew was talking about in the above verse. The “Faith Build” home will be constructed at 112 Hope’s Crossing Court here in Conway. We are partnering with Rev. Nathan See, Associate Pastor of Myrtle Beach Presbyterian Church, and his crew to help two days of the build.

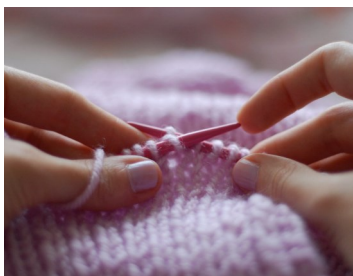


Those days are Saturday, September 10th, and Wednesday, September 14th. If you are available to help on one or both of those days, we would love to have your help. We will need 10 to 12 people to volunteer for at least one day. This is not limited to men alone. If you are 17 years old or older, and can swing a hammer, work with electrical or plumbing, Habitat needs your help.



Those who will be helping out will need clothing suitable for construction work, keeping in mind the outside temperature, water to drink, and comfortable footwear. Habitat should have tools available but if you have a special hammer or other tool that you prefer, feel free to bring it. Please contact Paul Reed, (856) 207-0370, and let him know which of the two days (or both) you can help out. The crews work from 8:00 AM until 3:30 PM and there is an hour for lunch. We need to let Nathan know how many members will be helping out for each day. The nice thing is that we will be providing an affordable, well built home for a neighbor here in Conway, not to mention the Christian Fellowship that we will build, with ourselves and Myrtle Beach Presbyterian Church but also with other people who will be working that day.

Thank you in advance for your help. I promise we will enjoy ourselves those days and come away with wonderful stories to tell.



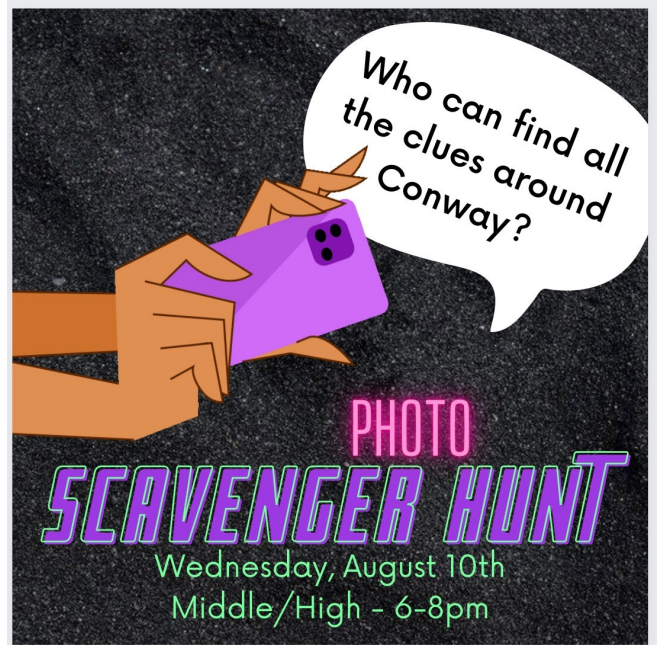

KIDS J.A.M. (Jesus and Me)

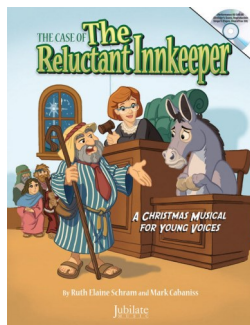


August 7
