
Dear Kingston Family,

I will never forget back in August of 2021, I think it was about a week after the Bannans arrived. We were in the midst of the delta wave of COVID, so Holly and I set up a zoom with our youth to get to know them, have a short devotional and time of prayer. It was really special, I could tell immediately we had some really talented and faithful young people here. Near the end, Holly and I shared our cell phone numbers and they did the same with us. After the zoom meeting concluded, we took a few minutes to text all the students present. A few minutes later I received a text message back from one of our high school students and it read "It was great getting to know you, this is the most interaction I have ever had from a KPC minister." I shared that with Holly, and we vowed at that moment that every single person under the age of 18 would know the both of us on a personal level. Since then Holly regularly has breakfast meetings with our students, we had a special confirmation class last year, and it is why every Sunday when it's possible. I invite one of our youth to help me lead worship. It is no secret that church attendance in America is on the decline and the greatest decline is the "Gen Z" crowd. We cannot change that overnight and there are many theories as to why that is happening. I cannot help but wonder though if Gen Z is losing their interest because the church has communicated either explicitly or implicitly "we do not care about you." Holly and I both try as best as we can to let our young people at Kingston know they matter. That they are not just another person in the congregation, they are important, so important in fact that we want them to help us lead worship. This Sunday is youth Sunday! Our middle and high school students will be leading the worship service from start to finish. Holly has done a fantastic job getting and continuing to prepare them for this special Sunday in the life of our church. I hope you will join us this Sunday and show your support for our young people as they lead us in both word and song! Every small act of support we show our youth is a huge spiritual investment in how they feel towards the church later on in their adult years. Pray for all of our youth, but pray especially for Sophia Smith, one of our high school seniors as she prepares to preach God's word to us this Sunday. Y'all are a great congregation and it's my joy to be your pastor.

Intensive Bible Study


