Resume on September 9<sup>th</sup> in the Fellowship Hall. The cost is \$8 for adults. Please join us for great food and fellowship!

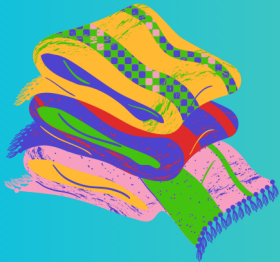
## COVERED DISH

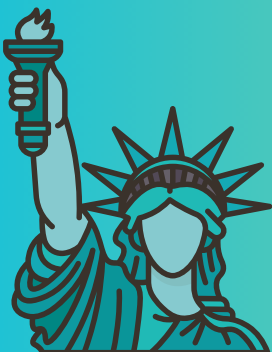
