Dear Kingston Family,

The month of March features two events I want to highlight. First, our Youth Sunday service will be this weekend, and I invite you to attend this special worship gathering. The entire service is led by our middle and high school students. It is a time to celebrate the gifts of God present in our young people while recognizing that our youth are more than just the "future of the church;" they are vital church members today. High school senior, Jordan Pressley (JP) Courtney, will be preaching the sermon, and I've enjoyed collaborating with her on it. I know you will feel the Spirit's presence as she delivers the message this Sunday.

Then, we have another special service on Wednesday — our Ash Wednesday service. Ash Wednesday begins the liturgical season known as "Lent." We receive ashes on this day to remind us of our mortality and to turn away from our sinful ways. Lent is a 46-day season of preparation between Ash Wednesday and Easter, symbolizing Jesus' 40 days of temptation in the desert by Satan before starting his public ministry. The purpose of Lent is to prepare Christians for the celebration of Easter, when the grave is conquered and death no longer holds the final say. I encourage you this Lent to consider what change you could make in your life that would bring you closer to Jesus. For some, this might mean giving something up; for others, it may involve adopting a new habit or spiritual discipline. Whatever it may be, I hope you will prayerfully reflect on how you can personally deepen your relationship with Jesus this Lenten season and begin Lent by attending our Ash Wednesday service, which will start at 6pm on March 5th in the sanctuary.

What happened to the "Gloria Patri"? What do "Kyrie" and "Sanctus" mean? These questions arise each year during Lent. In liturgical churches, and required in some denominations, it is traditional to refrain from singing the "Glory be to the Father" during this penitential season. As a result, the service music and hymn singing take on a more somber tone.

During Lent, we sing the "Kyrie," which is Greek for "Lord, have mercy," during the prayer of confession. We also use the "Sanctus," which is Latin for "Holy," as our response to the assurance of pardon. These responses will be used from Ash Wednesday through Lent.

Another tradition we observe is avoiding hymns that include the word "Alleluia." Instead, our hymns will focus on themes of suffering, atoning blood, and the sacrifice of Christ. However, as always, feel free to sing out with gusto!

The "Gloria Patri" will return as our congregational response on Easter Sunday as we celebrate the glorious resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.


