

Jesus Walks on the Water

Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, but the boat by this time was a long way from the land, beaten by the waves, for the wind was against them. And in the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. But when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" and they cried out in fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid."

And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me." Jesus immediately reached out his hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Journey Notes

Seven years ago, while on vacation in a little town near Santa Barbara, (Solvang) my family and I walked into an antique bookstore on the main drag. Carrie was pushing Callia outside the window while I paced through the Philosophy section compiling my reading list for the next summer. I was holding eight or nine books, clutched against my chest, fully engrossed in the moment and salivating with delight. Just as my excitement was at its peak, I heard the voice of God say to me "drop the books and look up!" I looked up. Right in front of me was a book. The title, "Prayer!" I dropped the stack of books, picked it up and began to read. My eyes welling up in tears, God said to me: "This is your life, it all runs on prayer!"

I have to admit, (and this is humbling) I have not fully absorbed this lesson. I am learning to be more fluent in prayer but I still feel the need to pray more. Like the disciples, I hope you will join me this week in asking our Lord: "Teach us how to pray!" (Lk. 11:1)

This week, try to believe this: until you pray, there will be no breakthrough! God is simply unwilling to move heaven to you until you move in prayer. So, shall we pray?

- (1) Pray that God and His kingdom's purpose would be foremost in your life (Matt. 6:33)
- (2) Pray for wisdom that you might know him better (Eph. 1:5-23)
- (3) Pray that all your needs would be met as you make his kingdom larger (Matt. 6:11)

If we pray this way, you will see a seismic shift in your life rhythm, appetite for joy and overall enjoyment of your life. We will see a breakthrough!
