



I think we all feel this way, but strangely, that's precisely why we He wants us--He wants to remake us and leave his imprint deep on our hearts. That's what Paul was praying for the Christians in Colossae (Col. 1:9-14)

This week, we are crying out to God and asking him to help us know him. But you ask, what would it take to get to know God?

- (1) Spend some time just reading His love letter, The Bible and just believe everything He says about you in it (Ps. 18:32, 1 John 2:12, Col. 2:10)
- (2) Spend some time praying and asking this God who already loves you and accepts you to make you more like himself (1 John 2:4)
- (3) Leave your house each morning as one who reflects the glory (joy, peace, presence) of God and bring that glory into your work, friendships and encounters (Matt. 28:18-20)
